Freeman of Greenville County in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said N. D. Freeman all that lot or parcel of land (formerly conveyed to said Adaline Burnham by Mrs Theresa Burnham dead) situated in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville and State aforesaid on the west side of Brown Street beginning at N.
