<p>Whereas by section 100 of an act of the General assembly of the State of South Carolina entitled "an act to reduce all acts and parts of acts providing for the assessment and taxation of property into one act and to amend the same" approved March 19, 1874 and as amended Dec 24th 1878 it is provided that each County Auditor in this State shall annually cause the list of delinquent lands in the County to be published weekly for two weeks preceding the day of sale in one newspaper and no more published in his County; and if no paper be published in said County then in some newspaper having the most general circulation in said County to which list there shall be attached a notice</p>		

given that the whole of the several parcels, lots and
parts of lots of real estate described in the proceed-
ing list or so much thereof as will be necessary
to pay the taxes, penalties and assessments charged
thereon, will be sold by Treasurer of Greenville
County, South Carolina, at his office in said
County, on the twenty seventh day of June 1881
unless said taxes, assessments and penalties be
paid before that time; and said sale will be
continued from day to day until all of said parcels,
lots and parts of lots of real estate shall be sold or
offered for sale; And whereas there appears on
the tax duplicates of Greenville County for the
year 1877 certain real estate consisting of one
city lot and house assessed in the name of W. B.
Smith and valued at Four hundred and twenty
Dollars the taxes, assessments and penalties
charged thereon amounting to Ten Dollars and
ten cents (4 10^{cts}) And whereas the above
named W. B. Smith neglected to pay to the
County Treasurer of Greenville County the
above taxes, assessments and penalties as prescri-
bed by law; And whereas in accordance with
the provisions of an act of the General assembly
of the State of South Carolina entitled an
act to provide for the redemption of forfeited
lands approved December 24th 1880 the Com-
ptroller General extended the time for the
advertisement and sale of the delinquent lands
in Greenville County, so that the sale thereof
might be held on the 27th day of June A.D. 1881
and the County Auditor of Greenville County
pursuant thereto, advertised the above descri-
bed property in the manner aforesaid as
delinquent land to be sold by the County
Treasurer of Greenville County on that day
and whereas at a sale so held by the County
Treasurer of Greenville County on that day
