The State of South Carolina  
To all to whom these pres-  
ents shall come: I Perry  
D. Gilreath, Sheriff of

Greenville County, and State aforesaid, send greeting.  
Whereas by virtue of a writ of fieri facias, issued out  
of the Court of common Pleas, held for the County of  
Greenville, tested the twenty seventh day of April  
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
and eighty at the suit of G. W. Farr to me directed,  
commanding me, that of the goods and chattels, lands  
and tenements of Baylis Farr to levy the sum of  
Six hundred and forty one <sup>29/100</sup> Dollars damage  
and costs, I have seized and taken of the lands  
and tenements of the said Baylis Farr, all that  
certain piece, parcel and tract of land, contain-  
ing Ninety nine acres, more or less, situated  
being in the County of Greenville, in the State afores-  
aid, adjoining lands of Mrs Baylis Farr and  
lots Nos 1 and 4 of J. N. Southern's survey of Baylis  
Farr's real estate, and whereas the said premises,  
with their appurtenances, since the seizure by me  
made by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias  
before mentioned, have been exposed to sale at pub-  
lic vendue, and purchased by Mrs A. P. Farr of  
the County of Greenville, in the State of South  
Carolina for the sum of Twelve hundred and  
twenty five Dollars being the highest sum that  
was bid therefor. Now know ye, that I  
Perry D. Gilreath Sheriff aforesaid, by virtue of  
said writ of fieri facias aforesaid, to me  
directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue  
of the Statute in such case made and provided, and  
for and in consideration of the said sum of Twelve  
hundred and twenty five Dollars to me in

hand paid, or secured to be paid, by the said Mrs A  
P. Farr the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby  
acknowledge, have granted bargained and sold, and  
by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto  
the said Mrs A. P. Farr her heirs and assigns  
forever, the said tract, piece and parcels of land  
with its appurtenances, and all the estate, right, title  
and interest which the said Baylis Farr of right had  
of in and to the same; To have and to hold the  
said piece parcel and tract of land, with its appu-  
rtenances, unto the said Mrs A. P. Farr her heirs  
and assigns forever as fully and absolutely, as  
I the said Perry D. Gilreath, might could or ought  
to grant bargain and sell the same, by virtue of  
the Statute aforesaid, and the said writ of fieri  
facias, or otherwise.
