sum of Six hundred Dollars to me paid by
J. A. Smith of Greenville County in the State
aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and
released and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release unto the said J. A. Smith all
those two tracts of land described as follows,
first tract, all that piece parcel and tract of
land lying and being in the County of Greenville
and State aforesaid on the waters of Gilders
Creek's waters of Coosee River beginning on a
stake thence N 10 1/2 E 25 to a hole in a stone
N 76 W 22 70 links to a stone & thence S 1/2
W 12 ch to a Rock & thence S 46 1/2 E 26 94
links to the beginning containing forty acres
more or less adjoining lands of Wm. Gandy
Martha P. Hawkins, C. S. Ray, Stephens, Gargine
and others. Second tract, all that certain
piece parcel and tract of land known in the
survey made by W. M. Shrelkeld Sept 24
1875 as tract No 9 and hath the following
