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S. L. Diakson of the County of Spartanburg  
in the State of aforesaid for and in consider-  
ation of the sum of Six hundred and  
sixty eight Dollars good and lawful  
money to me paid by J. P. Waldrop of the  
County of Greenville in the State of aforesaid,  
have granted bargained sold and released,  
and by these presents do grant bargain  
sell and release unto the said J. P. Waldrop  
all that certain portion parcel or tract  
of land situated lying and being in the  
County of Greenville and State aforesaid  
on Waters of South Saluda River and known  
as lot No. 2 on a Plat made by J. B. William-  
son Surveyor for myself of the several lots  
of the Carson tract as surveyed and divided  
by him November, the 30<sup>th</sup> 1881 Beginning at  
a large Walnut ox on said Saluda River and  
running thence N 24 W 23.00 to a large white  
Oak 3x thence N 50 E 17.55 to a stone 3x  
thence S 23 E 19.50 to a Birch on Bank of  
said Saluda River thence up the River with  
the meanderings of the same 19.66 to the  
beginning corner containing Forty one  
and three fourth acres be the same  
more or less and bounded by lots  
Nos. 1, 4, & 3 all of which is more fully  
shown by a plat made by said J. B.  
Williamson November 30<sup>th</sup> 1881
