ts shall come: S. J. Douthett master in and for
the County aforesaid, and greeting: Whereas
George B. Green in his own right Louisa C.
Hogansworth Emily L. Shoemaker Duich S. Cunningham
Sam and John R. Green on or about the 27th
day of September in the year of our Lord Eighteen
hundred and eighty one exhibited their complaint
in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid
