State aforesaid, containing one hundred and ninety acres more or less lying on waters of Tyger River, bounded on South by lands of widows Walloway - on West by lands of the Jackson estate on North by lands of Alfred Southern on East by lands of John Gravel and P. F. Meres the above described land was formerly the property of James Scott
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and now in possession of the following Legatees to wit: Parthena Kelly, Frances Trammell, Rebecca A. Johnson, Miss Annie F. Turner, A. L. Turner, Mary M. Trammell and Narcissa Cox. Together with all and singular the rights, mentions, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining. I have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Milton Trammell his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Milton Trammell his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs, and all other persons lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
