granted bargain sold and released and by these presents
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Andrew
J Green all that tract or parcel of land lying on
Rudy River and on both sides of the White Horse
Road in the County and State last aforesaid adjoin-
ing lands of Gibson, Thomas Rose Martin Hunt
& others containing three hundred and eighty nine
acres more or less said tract being known as the
Thurston place, devised to me by William Chrise
late of the County last aforesaid, deceased, - also
all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in
the County and State last aforesaid on the waters
of Armstrong Creek of Saluda River adjoining lands
of Martin, Andrew J Green & others being known as
the Green Bradley tract containing one hundred
and ten acres more or less and devised to me
by William Chrise late of the County and State
last aforesaid deceased. Together with all and
singular the rights members hereditaments and
appurtenances to the said premises belonging
in in any wise incident or appertaining. To have
and to hold all and singular the premises
before mentioned unto the said Andrew J Green
his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby
bind myself & my heirs, executors and administra-
tors, to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said Andrew J Green his
heirs and assigns against me and my heirs, and
