Doggett of Greenville County in the State of South Carolina have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain and release unto the said E. R. Doggett all that tract piece or parcel of land situated lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina about four miles from Greenville Road House near and pretty on Paris Mountain beginning at a stone on the corner N 30 E 20 chs. to a stone N. thence S 42 E 17.50 chs. to a stone N. thence S 30 W 20 chs. to a chestnut stump N. thence on 40 N. 17.50 chs. to the beginning corner containing thirty five acres be it the same more or less and bounded by Lot No 6 of the Marshal land Lot No 3 also Marshal's land and Lot No 1. also other and more particularly known as Lot No 2 in the survey made by W. P. Johnson Oct 21st 1878 and Plat Office together with all and singular the Rights Members Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to the same and to hold the same and singular the said premises before me and the said E. R. Doggett and his
