The State of Alabama Lowndes County Know all men by these presents that I, Mary

R. Norwood of Lowndes County in the State of Alabama, in consideration of the sum of One thousand Dollars, to me in hand paid, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, by Jesse W. Norwood, trustee of Josephine R. Norwood and her heirs (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, released and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the said Jesse W. Norwood trustee, all that lot in the City of Greenville State of South Carolina, which was conveyed to me by Octavia W. Rowland, by a deed bearing date the seventh day of October, one thousand eight hundred and eighty, and bounded as follows: commencing at the corner of Mrs Josephine R. Norwood's lot on Washington street and running along said street, sixty five feet to a stake, thence on a line parallel to the lower line of the

said Mrs Josephine R. Norwood's lot, to the lot of P. Wherle, thence along the said Wherle's lot, to the lot of Josephine R. Norwood, thence along her said line to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises, before mentioned, unto the said Jesse W. Norwood, trustee as aforesaid, and his successors forever. In trust nevertheless for the sole and separate use of the said Josephine R. Norwood for and during the term of her natural life, and after her death to her heirs, and also hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Jesse W. Norwood, trustee and his successors, against myself and my heirs and all persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
