Samuel S Gibbs of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of forty five hundred Dollars (\$4500) to me paid by Curran Mc Sloan of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Curran Mc Sloan all that certain piece parcel and lot of land situate lying and being in the City and County of Greenville in the State aforesaid containing three acres more or less and having the following lines meters and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake on West field Street and running thence N 70 3/4 W Six hundred and fifty three feet and two fifths of one foot to a stake on lands formerly of the Estate of John Westfield deceased; thence S 19 1/4 W two hun- dred feet to a stake; thence S 70 3/4 E Six hundred and fifty three feet and two fifths of one foot to a stake on Westfield Street thence N 19 1/4 E two hundred feet to the beginning corner being the same lot which was conveyed to me by Laura A Steele by deed of 8th January ad 1849 Together with all and singular the right member hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises together with hereditaments
