the sum of Two thousand Dollars to me in hand
paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by
George Marshall of Greenville County in the State
of South Carolina (the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged) have granted bargained sold and
released, and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release unto the said _____ all that lot
or parcel of land situate lying and being in the City and
County of Greenville and the State of South Carolina,
beginning at a stone on corners of Main and Broad
streets and running thence N 72° 30' W with Broad street
one hundred feet to an Iron pin on said street and
an alley twelve feet wide, thence S 17° 30' W with said
alley twenty nine feet and seven inches, to an Iron pin,
thence S 72° 30' E one hundred feet to an Iron pin
on Main street, thence N 17° 30' E with Main street
twenty nine feet and seven inches to the beginning
corner, with the right and privilege of using the well
of water on the lot adjoining the above described lot,
together with all and singular the rights members
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
premises belonging, or in any wise incident or
appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular
the said premises before mentioned unto the said George
Marshall his heirs and assigns forever, and I do
hereby bind myself my heirs executors and adminis-
trators, to warrant and forever defend all and
singular the said premises unto the said George
Marshall his heirs and assigns, against me
and my heirs and all other persons whomsoever
lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or
any part thereof.
