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To all whom these presents may concern, Whereas

I Nimrod Traynham of the above County and State in consideration of the love and affection I have for my wife Martha M. Traynham, and also in consideration of the fact that my said wife Martha M. Traynham was possessed of an inheritance from her father, the late Wm. Cool when I married her, which came into my hands and was invested in real Estate, and also further in consideration of one dollar in hand paid to me by the said Martha M. Traynham the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given granted bargained sold released and conveyed unto the said Martha M. Traynham, and by these presents do give grant bargain sell and release unto her all that tract of land whereon I now reside containing (103) one hundred and three acres more or less situate lying and being in Greenville County & State of South Carolina, on the road leading from the Augusta Road by the Arnold Mill on Keese Creek to Lumbing Shwals, bounded by lands of A. C. Stepp, Est. of Elizabeth Roberts deed, Jas. Gains and others, it being the land purchased with the money which came into my hands belonging to my said wife Martha M. Traynham as her inheritance, have the est. of Wm. Cool dead. Together with all and singular the rights, tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular

the said premises unto the said Martha M. Traynham her heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Martha M. Traynham her heirs and assigns from and against me and my heirs executors administrators and assigns and all other persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. And I also in consideration of the same facts that has caused me the said Nimrod Traynham to convey unto my said wife Martha M. Traynham the above described real Estate have sold bargained granted and conveyed unto my said wife Martha M. Traynham and by these presents do release convey and grant to her all the right and title that I now have to the following personal property, viz all the household & kitchen furniture I now own all the stock possessed by me, being three mules and seven head of cattle. Together with carriage wagon plantation & farming tools &c. to have and to hold all the above described personal property unto the said Martha M. Traynham her heirs and assigns, and I likewise bind myself her heirs and assigns to forever defend this personal property unto the said Martha M. Traynham her heirs and assigns from and against me or my heirs executors and administrators and all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
