ville S.C. and next door above the Mansion House  
in Cleveland Block. To have and to hold the said  
goods wares merchandise &c. unto the said  
S. J. Hunt and Mrs. J. Cromer their executors and  
assigns to them and their only proper use and  
behalf forever.
