 interest in that lot, parcel or tract of land lying,
 being and situate in County and State aforesaid,
 conveyed from Wm Jackson deceased, to James
 Jackson (his son) deceased, containing over ⁶⁰ hundred
 acres, more or less on the South West side
 of a conditional line, beginning on a white Oak
 corner, at the mouth of the Spring Branch, thence
 up said Branch, including all variations to a
 persimmon corner, thence N. W. to a Spanish
 Oak corner said described land lying on
 Wash Creek waters of South Tyger River
 County and State aforesaid. To have and to hold
 also all my household and kitchen furniture unto
 the said Thomasin McKinney her heirs and
 assigns forever, and the said Mrs Thomasin McKin-
 ney binds herself her heirs and assigns for the
 support and maintenance of the said Leana
 C Jackson during her natural life
