To all to whom these shall  
come: J Austin, D Vickers  
Sheriff of Greenville County,

and State aforesaid, send greeting: Whereas, by virtue  
of a writ of Fieri Facias, issued out of the Court of Common  
Pleas, held for the County of Greenville, tested the twenty  
eighth day of March in the year of our Lord one  
Thousand eight Hundred and sixty eight at the  
suit of Jeremiah Roberts to me directed, commanding  
me, that of the goods and chattels, lands and tenem-  
ents of George W Keyde to levy the sum of thirty  
three dollars damages and costs, I have seized  
and taken of the lands and tenements of the  
said George Washington Keyde all that certain  
piece, parcel and tract of land, containing thirty  
acres, more or less, situate and being in the County  
of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, on waters of  
Moores Creek and known as the Israel Charles
