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parcel or tract of land being and situate in the County and State of South Carolina and lying on waters of South Rabun Creek waters of Ruddy River in Fairview Township on both sides of the Ridge Road beginning at a stone in Ridge Road thence S 16° Indian boundary line 1400 to a stake 3 x 0 m thence N 88 1/2° W 10.00 to a stake 3 x 0 m thence S 57° W 4.00 to Red oak stump 3 x 0 m thence N 12 1/2° W 26.20 to a stone 3 x 0 m on J. Peden thence N 76° E 31.75 to a stake 3 x 0 m on J. H. Nash thence S 34° E 20.12 to a stake 3 x 0 m thence N 88 1/2° W 26.00 to the beginning stone 3 x 0 containing sixty five acres more or less together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said J.
