To have and to hold the said piece, parcel and tract of land, with its appurtenances, unto the said Portman Howard his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely, as I the said Perry D Gilreath might, could, or ought to grant, bargain and sell the same, by virtue of the statute aforesaid, and the said writ of fieri facias, or otherwise.

under the laws of the State of South Carolina, did on the ninth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty, cause to be executed to William D. Sullivan of Laurens County in said State, a deed of assignment of all the property of said corporation for the benefit of the creditors of said corporation, which said deed of assignment was duly delivered on the day of its execution, and is recorded in Book K K page 135 of the office of the Register of Meuse Courvance for Greenville County in said State, and whereas, the said deed of assignment authorized a sale of the property thereby conveyed, and in pursuance of such authorization, the said William D. Sullivan assignee under said deed duly advertised the property hereinafter described and conveyed, for sale at public outcry at Greenville Court House on Saturday the first day of July eighteen hundred and eighty two, on which last mentioned day the property hereinafter described was publicly and openly exposed for sale according to the custom of auctions, and was knocked down to Paschal D. Kouff, Charles A. Parkers, John H. Latimer and James H. Latimer at and for the sum and price of Twenty five thousand Dollars, they being at that price the last and highest bidders for the same. Now therefore know all men by these presents, that I the said William D. Sullivan, assignee of said Sullivan manufacturing company, by virtue and in pursuance of power and authority conferred upon me by said deed of assignment, and in consideration of premises and of the said sum of Twenty five thousand Dollars to me paid or secured to be paid by the said Paschal D. Kouff, Charles A. Parkers, John H. Latimer and James H. Latimer have granted, bargained and sold, released and conveyed, and do hereby grant, bargain, sell, release
