 ation of the sum of Seven hundred and thirty eight
 Dollars to me paid by Thomas Thompson of the
 County of Greenville in the state aforesaid, have
 granted bargained sold and released, and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell and release, unto the
 said Thomas Thompson his heirs and assigns forever
 all that piece parcel or tract of land situate lying &
 being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid
 and bounded as follows, to wit, Beginning at a small
 R. O. 3 x 0 on the road leading from Greenville City
 to White Horse Road thence S 27 W 19.50 to a pine 3 x
 0. Thence N 89 W 4.15 to a stone 3 x 0, thence S 11 E 16.60
 to a plow 3 x n pr Dogwood thence S 8 1/2 E 11.50 to a
 lighthouse knob 3 x n in road thence N 62 1/2 E 7.75
 to a stake 3 x n in the fork of road thence with said
 first mentioned road to the beginning corner
 containing forty one acres be the same more or
 less and for a more full description see plat at-
 tached to this deed - being the same tract of land
 conveyed to me by P. D. Gilvath Sheriff Greenville County
 and sold by him as part of the lands of James
