 by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
 unto the said Hattie C. Hawkins all that certain
 piece parcel or tract of land lying and being situate
 in said County of Greenville on the North Fork of Saluda
 River containing Four hundred and sixteen acres
 more or less, it being part of a tract of land form-
 erly owned by John Hawkins deceased and known
 as lot No. 3 laid out for the said Barnett C. Hawkins
