Humphreys all that tract of land, situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, on waters of North Saluda River, Beginning at a stake at the old run on said river, thence West 20.00 to the head of a ditch thence N 87 1/2 W 12.00 to a lightwood stake 3 x 3 x 0.00, thence S 26 E 5.00 to a stake at the head of a branch, thence down said branch 22.41 to a stone 2 x then S 36 1/2 E 9.60 to a chestnut oak 3 x 3 x 0.00 thence S 27 1/2 E 15.30 to a Red Oak 3 x 3 x 0.00, thence S 9 3/4 W 19.25 to a stone 3 x thence S 5 1/2 E 10.30 to a stone 2 x 2 x 0.00 on the side of an old road thence N 28 1/4 E 11.00 to a white Oak 3 x 3 x 0.00 at the head of a branch thence down said branch 38.44 to said River thence up said river 20.00 to the beginning corner adjoining lands of the said Evans A.
