 aforesaid, send greeting: Whereas, Elizabeth Park
 Excutrix and William Charles Excuter of
 George W. Richardson deceased, on or about the
 7th day of September in the year of our Lord
 Eighteen hundred and eighty one exhibited their
 complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for
 the County aforesaid, against W. W. Tarrant and
 J. A. Tarrant as administrators of W. W. Tarrant
 deceased, demanding judgment in relation to the
 Real Estate hereinafter mentioned and described, and
 the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the
