 for and in consideration of the sum of Eight  
 Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by King  
 Walker in the State of aforesaid, and Greenville  
 County have granted bargain sold and released  
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and  
 release unto the said King Walker a certain  
 piece or parcel of land containing fifty nine  
 acres the same more or less being a part of the  
 tract that I now live lying on the East side of  
 Armstrongs creek and bounded as follows  
 Beginning at the fork of the branch below the  
 old bridge thence down the branch S 75° to the  
 fork of another branch thence S 79° W 275 along  
 the Road to stake thence along the Road S 86° W  
 12.00 to survey gun thence to the Road S 8° W  
 15.30 to stake near a walnut tree thence N 79° W  
 11.10 to the creek at the mouth of the branch  
 thence up the creek to a willow on the old  
 Saw mill dam of James West deceased thence  
 N 15° W 15 to a pine tree S 89° W 30 to Rock stump

creek thence N 37 1/2° E 4.50 to a pine thence N 50° E 6.40 to  
 a pine thence S 64° E 20.00 to Rock out thence S 86° E 14.50 to the  
 beginning corner Together with all and singular the  
 rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to  
 the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident  
 or appertaining. To have and to hold, all and sing-  
 ular the said premises before mentioned unto the  
 said King Walker his heirs and assigns forever, and  
 I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and admi-  
 nistrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and

 any part thereof.
