ledged) have granted bargained, sold and released
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and
release unto the said Martha Lane, all that lot
or parcel of land situated in Greenville County in
the State aforesaid, in Greenville Township about 2
miles from Greenville Court House on East side of
the Greenville and Columbia Rail Road, beginning
on a Rock X thence S 68 1/2 E 3 chs to Rock thence S 8 1/2
W 4.16 chs to Rock X thence N 68 1/2 W 3 chs to Rock X
thence along the right of way of said road N 8 1/2
E 4.16 chs to the beginning containing one and one
fourth acres, more or less and bounded by lands
of Wm Batic lot No 2, and 3 and said Rail Road
together with all and singular the rights, members, heredi-
taments and appurtenances to the said premises
belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining,
To have and to hold, all and singular the said prem-
