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(father) on the one part and Thos L Henderson (son) on the other part witnesseth that the said W L Henderson doth grant unto the said Thos L Henderson the tract of land whereon he now lives together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging, to have hold and manage according to his own judgment, to him the said Thos L Henderson his heirs and assigns forever, against all such claims or any one claiming the same or any part thereof, Upon the following conditions on the part of the said Thos L Henderson being faithfully performed, that is the said Thos L Henderson doth furnish a sufficient support, to make comfortable the said W L Henderson and wife Rebecca A Henderson his wife during their natural lives and decent burial after death and further more, that the three single daughters, Mary Ann Henderson, Anetta A Henderson and Julia H Henderson, shall have a site to the place as a home, so long as they live or remain single. Possession given whenever desired, retaining only the site of home, these conditions to be binding until satisfaction, proof of a failure to comply with the same, and shall be revoked only by mutual consent of the parties and for the faithful performance

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Charles of said county and state for and in consideration of Twenty \$20⁰⁰ - Dollars to me in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do give grant bargain sell and convey unto L A Waldrop her heirs executors and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing one and one half (1 1/2) acres more or less being and situate in the county of Greenville of said State on the waters of Reedy River of Reedy River beginning at Rock on Spartaburg Road and at corner of said L A Waldrop thence on said road S 82 1/2 W about 140 yards thence near South about 60 yards thence near East about 96 yards thence on the line of said Waldrop about 70 yards to the beginning the points designated shall be corners for said land. Together with all lands tenements and hereditaments thereto incident appertaining or belonging, to have and to hold the said premises to her and to her heirs in fee simple, I do warrant and well defend that rights and titles to the said lands and tenements to
