Stiles, said Noble and others, the same being a part of a tract conveyed to me by J. M. Langley by deed bearing date 22^d day of March A.D. 1881. Beginning at a maple ox 0.70 on a branch at the crossing of a road and running with said branch as a line down to an oak ox 0.70 thence S 10 1/4 E 7.46 to a poplar ox 0.70 on another branch thence up said branch as a line to a poplar ox 0.70, thence N 1/4 W 24.87 chs to a stone ox 0.70 on a road, thence with said road as a line to the beginning maple. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said N. P.
