beginning on a Maple 3x, thence S 49° N 9 1/2' to a stone 3x m thence S 39° E 19,00 to a stone 3x m thence N 30° E 5,90 to a Pine 3x m thence S 40 3/4° E 11,50 to a stone 3x m, thence N 61° E 19,00 to a stone 3x m thence N 46 3/4° W 19,20 to a stone 3x m, thence West 18,20 to a Coplas 3x0, thence N 40 1/2° W 3,16' to the beginning corner along branch line

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said Premises unto the said Mary M Jones her Heirs and Assigns forever.
