Carolina and being in the State aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is  
hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released,  
and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the  
said Greenville Baptist Church all that piece parcel and lot of  
land situate, lying and being in the incorporate limits of the  
City of Greenville on the North side of Mr. Wm. Avenue formerly Common  
Street in said City and in the County and State aforesaid, fronting  
on Avenue Street now Mr. Wm. Avenue one hundred and fifty feet
