O. x on thence S 19 to a P. O. n. m. thence S 8 W 32 to a stake x n. m., and thence S 16 to E. to a stake n. m. containing ten acres more or less, together with all and singular the rights, manors, tenements and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; To have and to hold, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said John Pursley his heirs and assigns forever, And I as executor do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said John Pursley his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and the heirs of the late Louis H.
