 of Sixty two Dollars and fifty Cents to me paid by
 Samuel Williams of the County and State aforesaid
 have granted bargained sold and released and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell and release unto
 the said Samuel Williams all that lot piece or parcel
 of land situate lying and being in the County
 and State aforesaid on the South Branch of the
 waters of Peedy River containing two and half
 acres more or less bounded formally by lands of
 Adam Snyder Samuel Tober and John
 Williams more particularly described as follows
 in deed from John Williams to J. H. Deans
 dated seven the day of December A.D. 1860 begin-
 ning at a Black Oak on the East Part of said
 Creek running thence N. 70 E. for Chain and thirty
 links to a Rock 3x thence S. 30 E. on Chain and
 fifty links to a Rock 3x thence S. 70 W. thence
 and fifty links to a Stake on Rock 3x thence
 30 E. thence Chain to a Stake 3x thence S. 70 W.

 and fifty links to a Stake on Creek thence up the Creek
 now Chain to the beginning Black Oak
