 which is hereby acknowledged and have bargained and sold  
 and by these presents do bargain sell and convey to said Middle  
 Saluda Turnpike Company and their assigns  
 all title interest and estate of the party of the first  
 part in and to a tract of land in Greenville County  
 State of South Carolina adjoining the lands of W. A.  
 Bishop, Abraham Blythe and others bounded as follow  
 viz Beginning at a Spruce Pine on the West side of a  
 branch and between the Caesar Head and Middle Saluda
