West Street 40 feet wide, running in a Northwesterly direction to the City limits, Lower Street 50 feet wide, Beginning near the Southwest Corner of lot 37 on land descending lands of Mrs. Ware from the Trustee lands, then Northwesterly to the City limits, Mortley Street 40 feet wide, Beginning at Birney Street and North East Corner of lot No 1, thence Southeastly along R.R. to Eastern Corner of lot No 3, Leach Street 40 feet wide, Beginning on the South side of Birney St and opposite lot No 25, thence in a Southwesterly direction to the Southeast Corner of lot No 6, High Street 40 feet wide, Beginning on the North side of Birney St and running North easterly between lots Nos 19 & 18, 336 ft, Byrd Street 40 feet wide, Beginning on the South side of Lower St, Corner of lots Nos 50 & 51, thence Southwesterly to City limits, All the streets above described will more fully appear by reference to the before mentioned plat of H.
