

Grantee of Greenville County in the State of South Carolina in consideration of the sum of Three thousand dollars to us paid by Richard Harrison of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, have granted, conveyed, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, convey, sell and release unto the said Richard Harrison all our rights, title and interest in and to the undivided thirds in that parcel and tract of land containing two hundred and thirty six acres more or less, situate lying and being in Harrison Town ship in the County and State aforesaid out of the Creek of Rudy River, and adjoining lands of N. M. City, S. E. Harrison and others, and showing the following rules and bounds viz: Beginning at a Red stake 3x on a road and running thence S 43 1/4 E 64.00 to a stone 3x on the Jenkins Bridge Road, thence along said road as a line about 45.50 to stone 3x, thence N 61 W 82.00 to a stake 3x in the mouth of a branch in Crisples Creek thence on said creek as a line to a sycamore 3x at the fork thence S 1/2 E 6.42 across the creek to the beginning, Also all our rights title and interest in and to other Tract containing thirty four acres, more or less, lying on Rudy River below the mouth of Crisples Creek, Beginning at a Sycamore 3x on the River, and running thence N 50 E 13.00 to a stone 3x thence S 22 1/2 E 16.35 to a Red Elm 3x on the River, thence down the River as a line to the beginning, said two divided parcels lying Tracts Nos 2 & 6 of the lands of the Estate of John H.
