W. King have heretofore by final partition and divided the personal property and when as said firm at law have agreed to partition and divide the real estate between themselves without resorting to the Court excepting reciprocal titles due to them in respect interest in said lands, therefore know all men by these presents that we Horace L. King, Nancy King and Charles L. King for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid and of the sum of One dollar to us in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by Carrie King of the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, now granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Carrie King all of our right title interest and estate of every nature whatsoever of us, or to all and singular the premises herein after described, to wit all of that certain piece parcel or tract of land, situate lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid containing sixty five acres more

or less and having the following metes and bounds, Beginning at a stone 3 x 0 in Pinecomb Road corner of lot number one in Dickson survey of 25 July 1877 and running thence N 58 1/4 E 5.75 to a stone 3 x 0, thence S 68 1/4 E 4.5 to stone 3 x 0 thence N 32 1/2 E 3.62 to Poplar 3 x 30 to Mrs. Inman land thence N 54 1/2 W 13.88 to stone 3 x 0, thence N 37 E 22.59 to stone 3 x 0 in road leading from Truss Station to Chick Springs, thence with said Road to the Pinecomb Road, thence with said Pinecomb Road to the beginning corner. Bounded by lands of Mrs. Inman and others and known as lot number four in the Dickson survey.
