Together with all and singular the Rights, members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, Do here and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Henry S. Willis his Heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and defend against all and singular the said premises unto the said Henry S. Willis his Heirs and assigns against my and my Heirs and assigns every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
