 Whereas all men by the laws of the City and County of Greenville and of the County of Sumter, in the State of South Carolina, in consideration of the sum of \$1000 Dollars to and in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by Custace M. Wallis of the same City and County, in the State aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, conveyed, sold, released, and by these presents do grant, convey, sell and release unto the said Custace M. Wallis his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the County aforesaid in the City of Greenville in the State aforesaid in Main Street and butted and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning on the West side of Main Street at a stake, from which the direction course of the house of W. McKims Esq. Land No. 26 lies N 87° 4 E, thence at right angles to said Main Street N 77° W 248 7/10 feet to a stake, thence parallel to Main Street S 18° W 175 feet to a stake, thence S 73° E 248 7/10 feet to a stake on Main Street, thence up said Street N 18° E 175 feet to the point of beginning, containing one acre more or less, and which is fully represented by a plat of the same made by J. J. Jones D.S. on the 7th day of August 1883, and unto the said Custace M. Wallis his heirs and assigns, the Right, title, claim, and interest, and all appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; To have and to hold all and singular the said premises, unto the said Custace M. Wallis his heirs and assigns forever, And in default of heirs and assigns, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Custace M. Wallis his heirs and assigns, against all and every other

person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
