 This Indenture made the 13th day of September A.D. 1883, between W. A. Vaughan of the County of Greenville, the State of South Carolina, of the one part and Maria Pauline Humbell of the same County and State of the other part; Witnesseth, that the said W. A. Vaughan in consideration of the tender years of his son and his natural infirmity and inability to care for and properly raise and so manage, and in consideration, further of his indolent and feeble nature, and of his own free will and accord, give him the said Leiftrun Vaughan now about three years old, knowing his inability to care for and properly raise and so manage, and in consideration, further of his indolent and feeble nature, and of his own free will and accord, give him the said Leiftrun Vaughan to be raised, clothed, fed and educated the same as though he were the child of his own marriage, and to serve him faithfully as such, until he shall attain to the age of twenty one year, hereby conferring upon her the right to change the said name of my said son to that of Leiftrun Vaughan Humbell, and the said Maria Pauline Humbell, agree to be raised, clothed, fed and educated, as though he had been the issue of her own marriage, so long as she shall live with her, with the full right to the service of the said child until he shall attain the age of twenty one year, to the exclusion of his said father, and all other persons who may claim the same at any time during his minority.
