accord, bequeath, give and release unto James

1/19th of certain tract for about \$42.⁰⁰, of certain tract
containing 264⁰⁰ and thirty dollars in money also
one black cow slab, one chest, one feather bed
two head of hogs, one horse wagon, and lot of
tools and farming utensils, and all boxes, cets
and other refuse, and further more all my
right title and interest in my place known
as the Ponder place during my natural life
to be with as he the said James Milton Harrison
may choose, also I do give and bequeath unto
I may die possessed of, However be it known
that in making the above bequest it is the
intention, et al James Milton Harrison and
solely person is in consideration thereof that
he provide me with a decent and comfortable
support during the remainder of my natural
life, and that he care for and provide me
as he would care of his own family, otherwise
this agreement to be null and void and of
no effect.
