Know all men by these presents that I Daniel Ballou of the State aforesaid Greenville County in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars to me paid by Manly Bright and James Nelson in the State aforesaid Greenville County have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Manly Bright and James Nelson a certain piece or parcel of tract of land situated lying and being in the State and County aforesaid on a Branch Water of South Fork of River adjoining lands of Rachel Lindsey & H. Lindsey Nelson Howard James Cornick and land formerly belonging to Jacob Ballou beginning on a Hickory tree thence S 45 E about 18 Chains to a stake where said line strikes the Road then down the Old Road to the Corner of the fence to a Stake thence nearly East down said Branch to the Fork to a Stake thence nearly N 75 E till it strikes the Old fence then up the Old line to a Chestnut thence a Conditional line to a Branch to a Stake thence up said Branch to a Stake thence a Conditional line nearly N. W. to a Rock corner at a point

of Draw 7 Barrows thence nearly S. W. about 1 Chain to a Chestnut Oak 34.0 m thence nearly N.
