E. Harris is to be responsible to constitute a part of the consideration first above named for the one half interest therein conveyed, to be a credit on said 1st amt when paid by said S. E. Harris. To have and to hold the said undivided one half interest in the said street railway and appurtenances above mentioned unto the said S. E. Harris and his heirs and assigns forever.
