 granted, conveyed, sold and released, and by
 these presents do grant, convey, sell and release
 unto the said James Edward Earle his heirs and
 assigns a certain parcel or tract of land situate
 lying and being in the County of Greenville, three
 miles from Greenville Court house, better known
 as the old Christ Church Place, Beginning on a stone
 corner of John M. David and Jacob, on the line with
 said M. David line, N 60° 14' E 8 chains 2 links to a
 stone in said M. David line, near old road, thence
 N 72° 10' W 10.53 chains to a stone on old road, thence
 N 7 1/2° E 13.30 chains to a stone on old road,
 thence along said road, N 61° 30' W 2.50 chs to a small P.O.
 on road, thence N 50° 10' W 12.5 chs to a stake 2 m on side
 of old road, thence N 79° 10' W 16.45 chs to a small hole
 on 3 1/2 m, thence S 43° 1/2° W crossing the North fork
 of said Brushy Creek, 6.33 chs to a Chestnut 2 m
 thence S 84° 1/2° W 4.75 chs to a P.O. 2 m, thence S 74° 1/2° W
 23.70 chs to a stake, x in R.D. Earle line, thence
 with said line S 74° 1/2° E 24.64 chs to a stake, said
 R.D. Earle corner, thence S 80° 1/2° E crossing the South
 fork of said Brushy Creek, 18.75 chs to a small
 Hickory x, in bed on Road in Jacobs line, thence S 66° 3/4°
 crossing the Creek 20.60 chs to the beginning corner
 containing One hundred and twenty three acres
 more or less, particularly known as part of Alex
 M. Bus Brushy Creek Land, Together with all and sin-
 gular the Rights, minerals, Hereditaments, and ap-
