presents by Ganey Clint scales, in the state aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, non granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Ganey Clint scales all that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate in the County and State aforesaid in the Corporate limits of the town of Summit, near the Air Line Rail Road Depot, containing more or less (7/10) of an acre more or less and bounded by right of Way of Air Line Ry. - Air Line Ry. land, Nancy Clint scales, Monroe Marshall and stud, separate it from land of Johnson, and having the shape as is represented by a plat made by W. H. Hays and here to attached,

Do hereby with all and singular the Rights, muniments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise or direct or appertaining, I, heretofore and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Ganey Clint scales his heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Ganey Clint scales - his and assigns against me and my heirs and all others lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
