described to wit: all that piece, parcel of Land  
lying and being in the County and State aforesaid  
in Waters of Ladders Creek, Waters of Enoree River  
beginning on a Hickory 34, thence S 3, to a stake, thence  
N 78 27 46, 75 - to a Chestnut 34 37, thence S 23 27, 23  
chains to a stake, thence commencing on the  
beginning Hickory corner and ending N 78 27 46, 25
