 conveyed and by these presents do grant

gain, sell and release unto the Sallie L. Scott all
 of that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, situate
 lying and being in the County of Transville and
 State of South Carolina, containing One Hundred and
 Seventeen Acre more or less and has the following
 metes and bounds; Beginning on a White Oak Stand
 running thence S 71° 10' 15" E to a Stake 31
 E 33° 50' to a Black Oak 10 3/4; thence S. 1. Chain to a Stake
 31 on the Branch; thence down said branch to a stake
 31 at the mouth; thence up Little Horse Creek to a
 Maple 31; thence up the Spring branch to the begin-
