presents do Grant, bargain, sell and release  
unto the said Belle Gilmore All that tract of land  
situate lying and being in the County and State  
aforesaid, in Waters of Enoree River, bounded by  
lands of B. Balling, James Johnson and others, and  
containing One hundred and thirty acres more  
or less together with all and singular the Rights  
Members, Privileges and Appurtenances  
to the said premises belonging or in anywise  
incident or appertaining; and all the Estate  
right, title claim and interest whatsoever of the  
parties to the Cause aforesaid, and of each  
of them in and to the same; and of all other  
persons rightfully claiming from me or by  
them or any of them in and to the same; and  
of all other persons rightfully claiming from me  
or by them or any of them, To have and  
to hold all and singular the premises before  
mentioned unto the said Belle Gilmore her  
heirs and assigns forever, In Witness Whereof  
I the said Master in and for the County aforesaid  
said deed and by virtue of the aforesaid  
Order have hereunto set my hand and seal  
this 7<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord
