Williams of the City of Greenville in the State of South Carolina the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Henry B. Williams his heirs and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest and estate, of in and to all and singular the following described lot or parcel of land situated and being in the Corporate limits of the City of Greenville and State of South Carolina, and bounded as follows, Beginning at a Stake on Washington Street east side of main Street, corner of the corner lot, and runs East or north east with Washington Street fifty feet to the corner of the Engine House lot, thence north with Engine House lot Sixty feet to an Alley fifteen feet wide, thence with said Alley West, fifty feet to the corner of the Carous lot, thence with the line of the Carous lot Sixty feet to the beginning, being the same lot on which Henry B. Williams now lives, and on which the store houses of said Henry B. Williams and Richmond Williams now stand, my interest being one fourth interest in the lot and owned by my deceased brother Richmond Williams during his lifetime, the said lot being originally two lots, one deeded to Richmond Williams and the other to Richmond and Henry B.
