Goodlett all of that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate lying and being on Coffee Street in the City and County of Greenville and State aforesaid, beginning at a Stake on said Coffee Street Dorcus Osborne's line - and running thence S 71 1/2 E 58 1/2 feet to a Stake 3x, Mrs. Sango line; thence N 18 1/2 E 153 feet to a Stake P.D. Gilchrist and Mrs. Sango line; thence N 72 N 52 1/2 feet to Stake 3x, Dorcus Osborne's line; thence with said Dorcus Osborne's line to the beginning corner. It being one half of the lot of land deeded to me by A. P. Blythe as Assignee of Re. Dolphus Long a. B. a. on the second day of May 1881, and recorded in C. M. C. Office, Book M. M. page 40.
