piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and
being in Summerville County and state aforesaid
and having the following lines metes and bounds
to wit: Beginning at a stone in Pumpkin
and running S 75° 30' E 1/4 Sec 10 T 10 N R 10 W
to a stone then back

thence S 30° E 7/16 to a Pine, thence N 50° 1/4 E 10 ch to
State, thence S 30° E 1/2 ch to state, thence N 44° E 34.50
ch to State in Jones Gap Road. Thence with said Road
and Pumpkin town to the beginning. Bounded on the west
