Wood, all that piece, parcel and tract of land, situated, lying and being in Sumner County and State aforesaid, and being in two separate — and having the following lines, to-wit: Beginning at a Stone in the corner of Gap Road, thence N. 62° W. E. 72.5 ch. to white Oak, thence S 41° E 3.28 ch. to Red Oak, thence S 41° W 61.2 ch. to Stone in Jones Gap Road, thence South East to a certain well called Road to Stone on Russell's. To Stone corner, thence with Perkins Road to well met; Russell's Woods corner, thence S. 63.° W 21.15 ch. to Stake, thence N 30° W 31.0 to Stake, thence N 11° E 34.50 to the beginning. Bounded on the East by R. T. Woods land, on West by S. J. Woods land, land and tracts lying on the West side of South Saluda River, immediately behind Marietta Bridge, Beginning on a Stake on Cleveland's line near the Spring thence S 36° W 14 ch. to Victoria, thence S. 26° E 34.46 ch. to Birch on North Saluda River, thence with said River to the Marietta Bridge on Jones Gap Road, thence with said road to Black Gum (cut down) of H.
