Know all men by these presents that I William Henry Langford of Greenville County and State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One hundred and eighty eight and 60/100 Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Elizabeth M. Cleveland, of the State and County aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released and release unto the said Elizabeth M. Cleveland a tract of land situated lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid on the Waters of North Saluda River, bounded as follows: Beginning at a Post out at Naldrops corner thence South 44° W with Naldrops line to Public road thence with and down said road to State, a corner between Prichard and Elizabeth M. Cleveland thence East and with Elizabeth M. Cleveland's line to a Stake on Laidman's corner thence with Drummond's line to State, then North West with Bridges line to Maple Corner in front of Branch thence a straight line to the beginning Post out Corner. Containing fifty Acres more or less, all of which well more fully appear by plat hereto annexed. Together with all and singular the rights, privileges, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging in anywise whatsoever appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Elizabeth M. Cleveland her heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Elizabeth M. Cleveland her heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this twenty fourth day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Eighty five, and in the one hundred and Nineteenth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
